



Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid highlights key UAE milestones in 15th anniversary of his Accession Day



On the 15th anniversary of his Accession Day, His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice President, Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai, highlighted the key milestones that have placed the UAE as a leading nation in the region and the world through an open letter he wrote to the people of the UAE.

Through celebrating 15 years heading the federal government, he addressed the major achievements that have transformed the UAE's government work starting with the first federal strategy of 2007 to the announcement of the UAE Vision 2021 back in 2009.

In his letter, Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum stressed that the results of the UAE Vision 2021 are captured in the reality that the people of UAE are living in today.

He wrote, "We have established the principles of strategic planning in the government. Excellence and competitiveness have transformed into an institutional culture. We carried out the

biggest legislative reform in our country through issuing more than 50 new laws to help us adapt to the future."

He added, "the UAE government was ranked the second in the world in financial efficiency. We restructured the government several times to keep pace with the rapidly-changing world. We doubled the federal budget by 130 percent and boosted our competitiveness to make the UAE rank the first globally in 121 indicators across various fields. Our work is nowhere near the end."

Recalling the major economic leaps reaped through efficient government performance, he said, "Our economy is the second biggest in the Arab world, and our country is ranked the first regionally in attracting foreign investment and facilitating business. We are leading regionally in more than 437 global indicators, and our sovereign credit rating is the highest in the region."

On January 4, 2006, Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid became the Ruler of Dubai following the death of his elder brother Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid Al Maktoum, the then Ruler of Dubai. On 5

January, the members of the UAE Supreme Council elected Sheikh Mohammed as the Vice-President of the UAE.

On February 11, 2006, President His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, nominated Sheikh Mohammed to become the Prime Minister of the UAE; the Council approved this nomination.

Since then, Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid has achieved great strides in the UAE's government work, establishing an approach based on innovation and constant development. Through his futuristic vision, he has been leading an astounding development journey for the UAE, spearheaded primarily by young men and women who are empowered to innovate and actively take part in the country's achievements. Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid's leadership is based on the main principle of investing in the human capital out of belief that people are the basis of any nation's success. Thanks to this vision, the UAE has been leading on regional and global fronts across many developmental fields.

UAE residents without health cards may avail of free COVID-19 vaccine



Hospital, Burjeel Specialty Hospital, Prime Medical Center and Thumbyay Hospital. In Umm Al Quwain, residents may receive vaccination in government centers, including Al Bait Metwahid.

In Ras Al Khaimah, they may go to Expo

Center and Al Bait Metwahid of Idhn UAE residents without health cards may avail of free coronavirus vaccine, an official of the Ministry of Health and Prevention (MoHaP) said.

Hussein Abdul Rahman Al Rand, Assistant Undersecretary of the Ministry of Health for the health centers and clinics sector, told in an interview with Sharjah Radio and TV's program 'Direct Line', "The health situation in the UAE is reassuring, and we call on everyone to abide by the instructions and precautionary measures. Our wise leadership has provided us with the vaccine in all centers and it is provided for free to everyone, both Emiratis and expatriates, even if they do not have health cards, and there is no need for prior appointments."

These hospitals that conduct free COVID-19 vaccine in coordination with the Ministry are spread across the country, according to a report of Gulf Today.

In Sharjah, vaccination is provided at Al Zahra Hospital, Zulekha Hospital, Central Hospital, Saudi German

Center and Al Bait Metwahid of Idhn

The assistant undersecretary emphasized that for COVID-19 vaccine to be effective, one must be inoculated with two doses of it within a time period of 21 to 28.

He also said: "The vaccine is secure and is offered to age groups from 18 years and above. There are doctors in the centers who examine visitors to make sure that the vaccine is suitable for them."

Earlier, the MoHaP clarified that getting inoculated with COVID-19 vaccine is not mandatory for citizens and residents alike. However, the Ministry urges the elderly people and those with people at high risk of contracting the virus to get the jab.

The UAE registered China's Sinopharm COVID-19 vaccine for public use in December 2020, after it reported an 86 percent efficacy rate.

Dubai has also rolled out a COVID-19 vaccination drive using Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine.

Dubai Police's phone app notifies users of temporary street closures, major accidents

WAM: The Dubai Police General Command has launched a new feature on its smart mobile application, which notifies users of temporary street closures and major traffic accidents.

According to Brigadier Khalid Nasser Alrazooqi, Director of the General Department of Artificial Intelligence at Dubai Police, the new feature parts of the force's efforts to support and improve traffic management system in the emirate through reducing traffic congestion and redirecting motorists to alternative routes. "Providing the community with smart solutions reflects Dubai Police's keenness to achieve the strategic objectives of the government to transform Dubai into a smart city," Brig. Alrazooqi added.

"When a major accident that calls for a temporary road closure is reported to the Command and Control Room or



police patrols, road users will be then notified via Dubai Police app so they can seek alternative routes and avoid congestions," the director of AI in Dubai Police explained.

Brig. Alrazooqi confirmed that this service is expected to ease traffic flow on roads and increase customer satisfaction, especially during special occasions, celebrations and national holidays.

The new feature is now available via Dubai Police smart app on iOS and Android devices.

Sara Duterte tops list of Presidential candidates for PH 2022 elections – Pulse Asia



Davao City Mayor Sara Duterte ranked first on the list of Presidential candidates that Filipinos plan to vote for the upcoming 2022 elections.

Pulse Asia's latest survey reveals that Duterte received 26% of the total votes, while former Senator Ferdinand "Bongbong" Marcos and Senator Grace Poe tied in at 2nd with 14% each.

Sara Duterte has yet to make any official announcements if she will be running for president for the 2022 elections.

Incumbent Manila Mayor Isko

Moreno ranked 4th with 12% while Senator Manny Pacquiao followed at 5th with 10%

Current Vice President Leni Robredo ranked 6th with eight percent of the survey respondents who chose her to be the next president of the Philippines.

Meanwhile, Moreno took the top spot for the Vice Presidential preference among Filipinos with 17% of the votes, closely followed by Duterte at 16%.

Senator Tito Sotto came in third at 14% while Marcos and Pacquiao tied in as Vice Presidential candidates with 11% each.

Philippine Red Cross aims to vaccinate 1 million Filipinos against COVID-19

The Philippine Red Cross (PRC) has expressed its plans to vaccinate up to one million Filipinos against the coronavirus disease (COVID-19).

Senator and PRC Chairman Richard Gordon revealed that his team managed to vaccinate a million Filipinos for polio and measles, and that they plan to do the same once a COVID-19 vaccine has been approved for public use in the Philippines. "Ang goal namin one million [vaccines]. 'Yan ang pinag-usapan namin ng aking mga staff kasama ang mga doktor namin," said Senator Gordon in an interview with CNN Philippines.

However, Senator Gordon also stressed that while they at Red Cross are ready to provide vaccines for the public, he blasted the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) anew for its longstanding debts for the COVID-19 testing that has reached millions of pesos.

"We are going to do it with the Red Cross kung papayagan kami but again, ayaw ko pang pumasok diyan dahil ang laki pa ng utang ng PhilHealth.



Hanggang hindi nababayaran 'yan, we cannot go and commit ourselves again to baka another wild goose chase trying to get it out," explained the PRC chairman.

He also stressed that while international donors may extend help to the Philippines, they may also raise concerns as to why the government's debts to the local Red Cross organization remain unsettled

to date.

"Ako makakakuha ako ng tulong sa ibang international Red Cross societies pero syempre at the back of their heads 'Nanghilingi ka ng tulong pero 'yung utang sayo ng gobyerno mo... tinulungan mo na, hindi ka binabayaran P800 million na aabot ang test, bakit ka hilingi sa amin?" said Senator Gordon.

Marine plastic pollution surges with estimated 1.56 billion face masks thrown in oceans this 2020 – study



A concerning wave of pollution brought about by the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic is harming the Earth's oceans, with an estimate of 1.56 billion face masks dumped around the world's waters according to a study.

Hong-Kong-based marine conservation organization OceansAsia's study "Masks on the Beach: The Impact of COVID-19 on Marine Plastic Pollution" suspects that the irresponsible dumping of face masks in the oceans will result to an estimated 4,680 to 6,240 metric tons of plastic waste that will have a negative impact on marine wildlife and ecosystems.

OceansAsia urges the public to rely more on reusable masks as often as possible and for the proper disposal of

single-use masks in order to preserve the environment.

It also called on governments to do the following preventive measures:

- Implement policies designed to encourage the use of reusable masks, such as releasing guidelines regarding the proper manufacture and use of reusable masks.
- Foster innovation and the development of sustainable alternatives to single-use plastic masks.
- Discourage littering by increasing fines, and educate the public about responsible ways to dispose of masks.
- Repair and improve waste management systems to reduce losses and spillage.

Feng Shui Master Hanz Cua says tech business to boom in 2021

In April 2020, Abu Dhabi-based OFW Bionaflor Padrigo contracted the coronavirus disease (COVID-19).

She got sent to a hotel for initial quarantine prior to getting her test results. When Padrigo tested positive, she was sent to the Humanitarian City in Musaffah - a dedicated quarantine area for individuals who have contracted COVID-19. There, health authorities and frontliners took care of Padrigo until she got better by June 29.

"Ako po mismo na-experience ko kung paano ang asikaso at pag-iingat sa bawat patient. Everyone was treated equally and the best po ang kanilang pangangalaga in terms of physical, emotional and health comfortability. Talagang may assurance that you are in good hands," recalled Padrigo, who works as an optometrist in the capital.

Padrigo's story is but one of the many inspiring stories that prove how the UAE came in prepared to protect everyone living in the country from the huge impact of the

pandemic. The country launched comprehensive initiatives and provided solutions for everyone to pull through the year.

"As a COVID-19 survivor, and experiencing how UAE cared and fought against COVID-19, I am with them in prayer and there is no doubt it will end soon. Living here for more than 10 years, isang pribilehiyo ang ma-witness at ma-experience ang buhay UAE. Malinaw yung mensahe sa akin na welcome ka dito, at iingatan kita," said Padrigo.

Almost a million Filipino expats living and working here bore witness as to how the UAE has risen to the challenge of the pandemic.

SUPPORTING GROWING BUSINESSES

When the pandemic hit the UAE, business owner Ann David was worried that her tailoring company would struggle when it comes to demand since sports events came to a halt. However, she managed

to rethink the strategy from selling sports jerseys to manufacturing reusable cloth masks and has since managed to continue providing jersey clothes for those who would request in batches.

“As business owner, we are thankful that we survived 2020. And we've learned a lot especially since you never know how long this pandemic could last. Abu Dhabi launches 'Choose to Vaccinate' campaign with free COVID-19 vaccines for all residents

A Covid-19 vaccination campaign has launched in Abu Dhabi under the supervision of the Department of Health – Abu Dhabi and the Abu Dhabi Public Health Centre.

The “Choose to Vaccinate” campaign asks everyone to get vaccinated to protect themselves against Covid-19, with the understanding that together we are protected.

All UAE nationals and residents can receive the free Covid-19 vaccine.

Abu Dhabi’s rigorous approach to managing the pandemic, including mass screening and testing and active tracing, has allowed the emirate to successfully maintain a low rate of 0.39 per cent of confirmed cases out of total tests conducted in the emirate.

The vaccination campaign aims to preserve the health achievements attained so far in curbing the spread of Covid-19, and ensures Abu Dhabi will continue to lead the way in comprehensively protecting the population.

Sheikh Abdullah bin Mohammed Al Hamed, Chairman of the Department of Health – Abu Dhabi, said: “The Covid-19 pandemic has challenged the world in an unprecedented manner. In Abu Dhabi, we are proud to have prioritised protecting our community and curbing the spread of the virus, while being active in finding solutions by partnering with other global leaders to participate in



clinical trials that have contributed to ensuring a vaccine is now available.

“As we enter 2021, we want to ensure our people continue to be safe, which is why the vaccines have undergone rigorous trials to ensure their safety, efficacy and quality. I hope you choose to vaccinate to protect your health and the health of our nation.”

Dr. Jamal Mohammed Alkaabi, Undersecretary of Department of Health - Abu Dhabi, said: “The approved Covid-19 vaccines are safe and will give recipients the immunity needed to protect themselves. I hope everyone chooses to vaccinate to help get our lives back to normal.”

Matar Saeed Al Nuaimi, Director General of Abu Dhabi Public Health Centre, said: “Getting vaccinated is

the simplest and most effective way to stay safe. Throughout history, vaccines have saved millions of lives around the world.

“Covid-19 will not disappear unless we fight back and the most effective way to do that is with vaccines. I hope everyone chooses to vaccinate, to break the infection chain and be a part of victory against this pandemic.”

Dubai begins vaccination drive for frontliners, employees in vital professional in government sector



Dubai Health Authority (DHA) announced that it has begun the vaccination drive for frontliners and employees in vital professionals in the government sector.

Dr. Farida Al Khaja, CEO of Clinical Support Services and Nursing Sector at the DHA and Chairperson of the COVID-19 Vaccination Steering Committee, said the vaccination drive is in line with providing vaccines for priority groups in the first phase.

“These employees are public-facing employees, we are truly thankful to all frontliners across all sectors. We have received the list of these employees after coordination with relevant stakeholders across all government departments and we have booked their appointments.”

DHA will also shortly begin the same process for frontliners in the private healthcare sector, as they are a priority group.

Dr. Al Khaja said, “In the first phase, Emiratis as well as residents above the age of 60 years, people of determination, people with chronic diseases, frontliners in the public and private sector and people in occupations with the highest COVID-19 risk are eligible. In the next phase, other segments of society will be eligible.”

In terms of the vaccine, she said, “Vaccination comprises of two doses, taken separately. The gap between the two doses is 21 days. The vaccine is given in the muscle of the upper arm. For the vaccine to be effective, it is necessary to adhere to the appointment of the second dose as per the stipulated time.”

MASSIVE VACCINATION CAMPAIGN

Following months of countrywide sterilization campaigns on the streets, buildings, and public spaces, and mass testing for COVID-19 that has now reached over 21.6 million, the country became among the first worldwide to approve two COVID-19 vaccines for use for the general public: the Sinopharm vaccine from China that underwent the third phase of human trial in the country’s #4Humanity Trials back in July, as well as the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine

jointly created by laboratories from USA and Germany that applied for emergency use in December.

Among those who have already received their vaccine shots is Jean Mary Perdiz, a shadow teacher who has been working the country for 12 years. She shared that she decided to take the vaccine not only to protect herself from the virus, but for the welfare of the students she teaches as well.

“Napagdesisyonan ko po na magpa-covid-19 vaccine dahil po sa school ako nagwork para po sa safety ko at safety narin ng mga studyante namin,” shared Perdiz.

Perdiz received her first dose as part of the UAE’s emergency use campaign last November 11 and got her second dose last December 5. She shared that she only experienced minor pains when she got the jab.

“Nung unang vaccine po ay medyo nakaramdam ako nag pagkahilo which is normal naman po yun sa side effect nung vaccine,” said Perdiz who thanked the UAE government for providing assistance for frontliners like her to fight against the coronavirus disease.

“The UAE is always willing to provide all the medical assistance, including free-swab tests, and now the provision of the COVID-19 vaccine for frontliners like myself and residents too. On behalf of my fellow teachers, we wish to extend our sincerest gratitude to the UAE government from the bottom of our hearts. We can proudly say that we can defeat COVID-19 here in the UAE! Thank you,” she added.




